Youth Division: Under 16

Adult Division: 17+

Rules for Needlework:

1. *One 3x5 index card with name, address, phone number, and description of entry, including any notes you may want to share must accompany each article.*
2. *Judging will take place on Tuesday, September 5 at 7:00 pm. No one is allowed at the judging.*
3. *Articles must be in new to excellent condition and completed by the exhibitor between September 2022 and August 2023. No machine-made articles are eligible (except as noted). Articles will be judged on originality and workmanship.*
4. *All articles must be completed and framed if necessary.*
5. *Textile paint products and dressmaking projects are not eligible for adjudication but may be submitted for exhibition.*
6. *Limit 2 entries per person per section for adjudication; additional entries may be included for exhibition.*

SECTION I. – Crocheting

A ribbon awarded to the best exhibit (if any) in Section I.

Classification:

1. Placemats, potholders, and other household accessories
2. Tablecloths
3. Doilies
4. Scarves, stoles, shawls, and ponchos
5. Sweaters, dresses, and other clothing items
6. Children and infant clothing items
7. Accessories- hats, gloves, socks, purses, etc.
8. Toys



SECTION II. – Knitting

A ribbon awarded to the best exhibit (if any) in Section II.

Classification: Same as Section I.



SECTION III. – Needlepoint

A ribbon awarded to the best exhibit (if any) in Section III.

Classification:

1. Samplers
2. Pictures
3. Wall Hangings
4. Purses and Accessories
5. Pillows
6. Miscellaneous



SECTION IV. – Embroidery, Cross Stitch

A ribbon awarded to the best exhibit (if any) in Section IV.

Classification: Same as Section I.



SECTION V. – Quilt

A ribbon awarded to the best exhibit (if any) in Section V.

Classification:

1. Hand pieced, hand quilted
2. Machine pieced, hand quilted
3. Machine pieced, machine quilted
