### Rules for Needlework:

- 1. One 3x5 index card with name, address, phone number, and description of entry, including any notes you may want to share must accompany each article.
- 2. Judging will take place on Tuesday, September 5 at 7:00 pm. No one is allowed at the judging.
- 3. Articles must be in new to excellent condition and completed by the exhibitor between September 2022 and August 2023. No machine-made articles are eligible (except as noted). Articles will be judged on originality and workmanship.
- 4. All articles must be completed and framed if necessary.
- 5. Textile paint products and dressmaking projects are not eligible for adjudication but may be submitted for exhibition.
- 6. Limit 2 entries per person per section for adjudication; additional entries may be included for exhibition.
