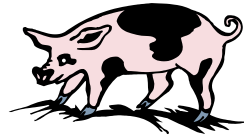
Animals should arrive at the fairgrounds on Thursday between 1:00pm and 6:00pm unless prior arrangements have been made with the livestock chairperson.

Open to all as:

Grange and Open Class

1. Novice Division – Ages 7 & under (Poultry only)
 2. Junior Division – Ages 8-12
 3. Senior Division – Ages 13–19
-
1. All animals must be taken care of at least twice (2X) a day. If an animal is not taken care of, the owner will be contacted for care or removal. All animals must be appropriate for showing.
 2. Animals who exhibit inappropriate or dangerous behavior may need to be removed.
 3. All livestock **MUST** be vaccinated for RABIES by an accredited veterinarian, at least 21 days prior to the fair and two copies must be provided to the fair.
 4. All animals must be examined by the fair Veterinarian.
 5. All male livestock must be neutered.

CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS FOR EACH ANIMAL TYPE:



CATTLE

Brucellosis – N.Y.S. cattle are eligible for exhibit without test.

Tuberculosis - Originating in a clean herd tested within five (5) years or tested negative within sixty (60) days of the fair. Animals under two (2) years of age are not subject to test.

H.S. Vaccine – Active immunization against shipping fever complex not over ninety (90) days and not less than ten (10) before the fair. Serum or

antibody concentrate cannot be used in lieu of vaccination. Health and vaccination certificate to be submitted as indicated above.

GOATS

Health certificate and rabies vaccinations certificate required for all animals. Health and vaccination certificate to be submitted as indicated above.

LLAMA & PIGS

Must be double fenced with no public contact. Health certificate and rabies vaccinations certificate required for all animals. Health and vaccination certificate to be submitted as indicated above.

SHEEP

All sheep must be accompanied by a health certificate signed by an accredited veterinarian identifying the animals to be exhibited and indicating that the flock has been inspected and found free of all contagious infections or communicable diseases and that the animals to be exhibited were included in that inspection. Health and vaccination certificate to be submitted as indicated above.



HORSES

Negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) conducted during the present calendar year (2016) and health and vaccination certificate to be submitted as indicated above, (two copies).

DONKEYS

Same as Horses above.
