The Needlework competition is open to Adults and Children. We encourage everyone to enter his or her exhibits. We appreciate your support.

Drop off: Monday, September 6: 7:00pm – 9:00 pm
Tuesday, September 7: 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm

1. Three 3x5 cards with name, address, phone number, description of entry must accompany each article.
2. Judging will take place on Tuesday, September 7 at 7:00 pm. No one is allowed at the judging.
3. Articles must be in new to excellent condition and completed by the exhibitor between September 2020 and August 2021. No machine-made articles are eligible (except as noted). Articles will be judged on originality and workmanship.
4. All articles must be **CLEAN!!!**
5. All articles must be completed and framed if necessary.
6. Textile paint products and dressmaking projects are not eligible.

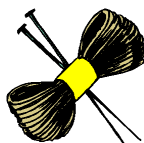
Classification
